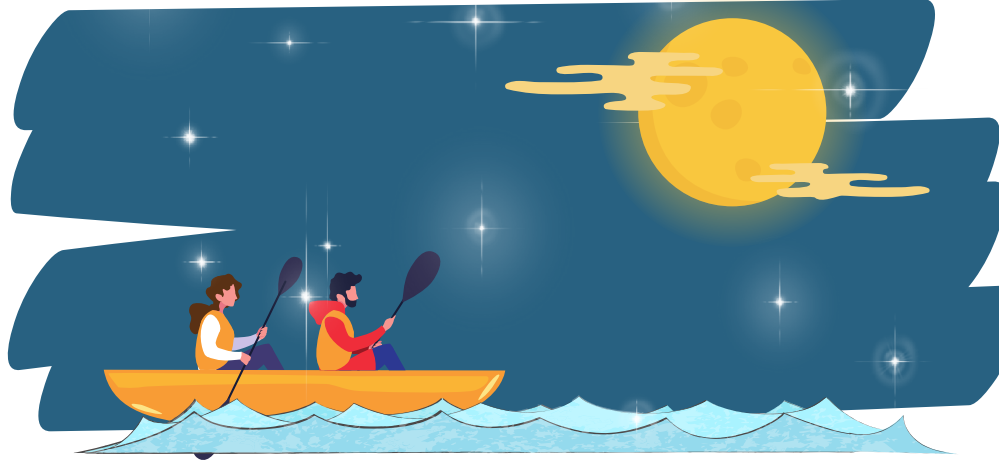

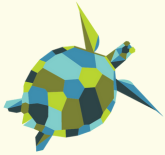
FROM THE SDMBBSC BYLAWS ARTICLE II – PURPOSES SECTION 1 –

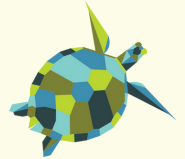

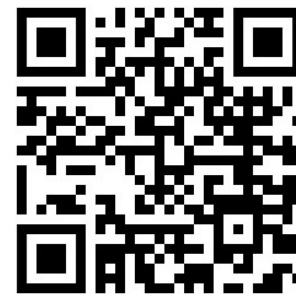

Vessel Storage Application: Members Only

Thank you for your interest in vessel storage at the San Diego Mission Bay Boat and Ski Club. Prior to authorization to storage, there are a couple of administrative tasks you must complete. First, please complete the Vessel Storage information on your SDMBBSC Membership Profile. All instructions can be found at the following link: <https://sdmbbbsc.org/vesselstorage>.

Request for vessel storage must be completed in writing via email to boatyard@sdmbbbsc.org. Once your request for storage is received, all information will be reviewed for vessel storage eligibility.

SDMBBSC Vessel Storage Requirements:

1. Current Vessel Registration
2. Current Trailer Registration
4. Photo of Vessel on trailer.
5. Vessel insurance with SDMBBSC named as additionally insured.
 - o Owners of all boats and trailers must maintain a minimum liability insurance policy of \$100,000 (One Hundred-Thousand) for injury to personnel and \$300,000 (Three Hundred-Thousand) for damage to property. The insurance shall list the SDMBBSC as "Additionally Insured" in accordance with SDMBBSC insurance policy.
 - o This item is usually a no-cost effort from an insurance company.

The SDMBBSC Vessel Storage Requirements must be uploaded to the member account prior to vessel storage at the facility

Space assignment will be at the discretion of the Boatyard Manager(s) and may be reassigned if in the best interest of the club. Spaces cannot be passed between members without permission of the Boatyard Manager(s).

WAIT LIST:

A wait list is maintained by the Boatyard Manager(s). Persons may be added to the wait list upon written request to boatyard@sdmbbbsc.org. Those persons that have uploaded ALL of the above information may receive priority when spaces become available. Also, vessel storage spaces at SDMBBSC are of varying sizes and may limit timely placement of vessel at the facility.

All vessel spaces must be maintained in a neat and presentable condition at all times. Boats and/or

trailers

must be stored in their assigned space and must be kept in operative condition at all time as required by the requirements of the SDMBBSC lease. No other vehicles or equipment is allowed for storage at SDMBBSC.

EASY TO UNDERSTAND STANDING RULES - DOGS

- 4.1 **Only SDMBBSC members** may bring a maximum of three (3) of their own dogs onto the premises.
- 4.2 Dogs are allowed off leash between dawn and dusk **provided the member is directly supervising** the dog(s).
- 4.3 **Dogs are NOT ALLOWED INSIDE the Clubhouse or Bar** with the exception of those approved by the State of California and San Diego County for the disabled.
- 4.4 **Dog owners are responsible for cleanup** after any dog they bring to the club. Dog owners shall not hold the SDMBBSC responsible for the health of their dogs or actions by their dog or other dogs brought to the Club. **Members who bring their dogs to the Club are responsible for canvassing the entire lawn area prior to departing to cleanup any poop encountered, regardless** of whether the Member believes their dog was responsible for the poop.

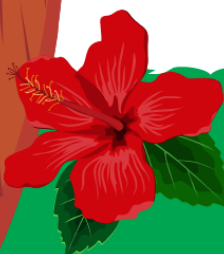
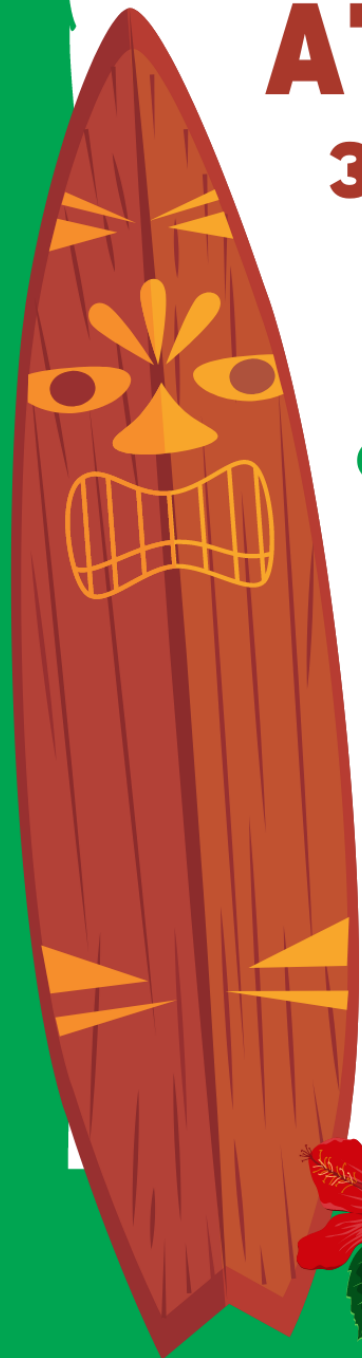

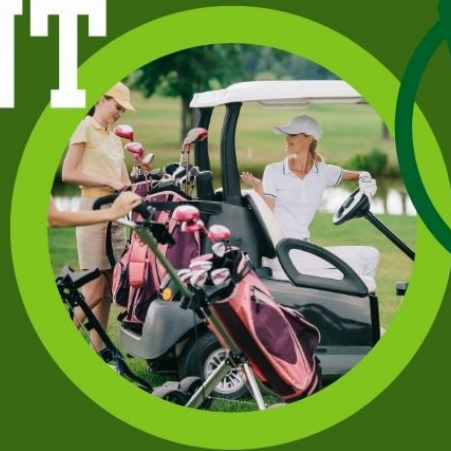
