



San Diego Mission Bay Boat & Ski Club Boat Yard Rules

Park in assigned space at all times. Speed limit in yard and on premises is a maximum of 5 mph, or a safe speed that will not raise dust, debris, or create a safety hazard or damage the surface of the premises.

Boat and Trailer to be kept in good condition; tires inflated, reasonable good appearance.

Keep spaces clean, free of weeds and debris. No trash, hazardous materials, or equipment storage in spaces. No dumping of hazardous waste.

No alteration of space, additions of structures, etc...

No electrical hookups without permission (an extra fee may apply).

Fish cleansings will be double bagged and sealed before placing in dumpster. All wet garbage to be bagged and sealed.

If locks are applied to the trailer or boat that prevents movement, keys or combinations will be supplied to the SDMBBSC Boat Yard Manager(s).

Space is for storage of named Boat and Trailer. No other material or vehicles allowed.

Wash down of Boats and Trailers and Flushing of Engines only at the Launch Ramp.

No washing in spaces. Any cleaning material or dust must be confined to the space and cleaned up immediately after cleaning, polishing, or repair.

Only minor maintenance is allowed in the boat yard or in the assigned space. Written permission must be obtained from the Boat Yard Manager(s) before commencing anything other than minor maintenance.

Tarps/covers must be secured and in good condition at all times.

Standing water in a boat or within a space should be removed promptly after rain, flooding, spill, etc... to prevent the attraction of insects or vermin.

Boats and Trailers may be moved at any time to facilitate yard maintenance, operations, and storage of space changes.
