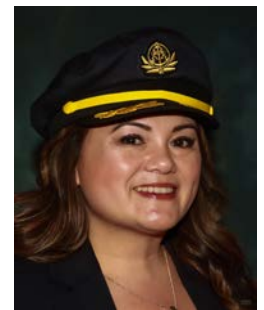

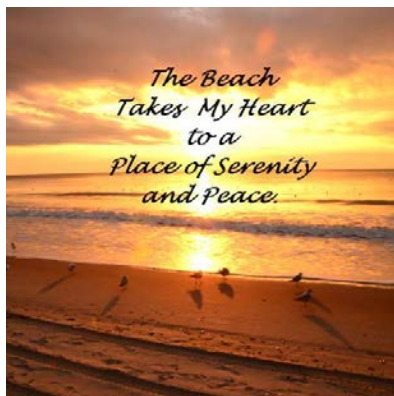

ARTICLE IV – DUES AND FEES

SECTION 7 – RESIGNATION: Any Member who wishes to resign in good standing must be current in all monies owed to the SDMBBSC. Any Member so resigned may resume membership by application in accordance with Article V **REINSTATEMENT**. A Member read out in good standing is **not allowed to return to the SDMBBSC as a guest for a period of six (6) months** from the date of written notification to the SDMBBSC. A Member read out in bad standing is not welcome at the SDMBBSC until the resolution/restitution has been made and accepted by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V – REINSTATEMENT

SECTION 1 - Member in Good Standing: Any Member in good standing who resigns from the SDMBBSC may later submit an application for membership that is subject to approval of the Board. The Member can be **readmitted to membership upon payment of a readmission fee equal to 30% of the current Flag Membership initiation fee**. Upon receipt of an application, the Commodore shall cause the applicant to be re-introduced to the Membership and the application to be read at the next regular Flag meeting.

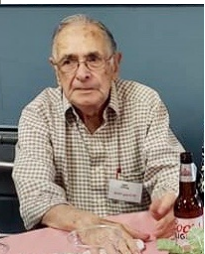

TO ALL MEMBERS:

It has been nearly 6 months now since San Diego, California, the United States, and the world have shut down due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Club's Board of Directors has worked tirelessly in the past 4 months to get the Club up-and-running again so that we can serve our members in the way they've come to expect, and we've made some significant progress. The Club has reopened on a limited basis Thursday-Sunday including Friday Night Dinner, Sunday Brunch, and Pizza Thursday and Saturday, with occasional entertainment. The Club has also renovated the bathrooms and repaved the parking lot.

However, with the chaos of the last few months, we're seeing a significant number of members becoming delinquent in their accounts, and many members questioning the assessment and AutoPay processes. We want to clarify the ins and outs of the billing process.

Regular Flag memberships are invoiced on a monthly basis. This includes the dues and boat storage fees (if applicable). The invoice is generated on the 1st of the month unless you're on AutoPay, in which case it's invoiced/charged on the Membership Portal (www.sdmbbsc.org) on the 15th of each month.

Limited/Associated memberships are billed on an annual basis. This includes Ikuna Koa, and the Golden State Fly Fishers. The invoice is generated on the 1st of the month. AutoPay is not available for this type of membership.

Food/Beverage/Merchandise assessments are charged to all Flag and Limited memberships on a quarterly basis. For Flag memberships, the amount is \$90, for Limited memberships, the amount is \$30. The 1st quarter is Jan-Mar billed in Apr, the 2nd quarter Apr-Jun billed in Jul, the 3rd quarter is Jul-Sep billed in Oct, the 4th quarter is Oct-Dec billed in Jan.

- You can eliminate or reduce this assessment by spending money at the Club on food, beverages, merchandise, and event tickets. If you spend \$90 (or \$30) during the quarter, you won't have to pay the assessment. Any amount spent less than \$90 (or \$30) is deducted from \$90 (or \$30).
- Food/Beverage/Merchandise assessments **are NOT charged to your card on AutoPay, and must be paid separately.**
- Your statements include line items of what you spend at the Club. This data for the prior month is uploaded at the beginning of the month. Statements issued won't show spending for the current month.
- ***Due to the pandemic, the Club was closed April/May (the first 2 months of the 2nd quarter of 2020), so the assessment was reduced to \$30 (or \$10) because the Club was only available in June.

One-time/Short-term assessments are occasionally charged to all Flag and/or Limited memberships. The Board of Directors occasionally call on the membership to help pay for improvement projects that the regular budget doesn't cover.

- Unlike quarterly assessments, these assessments can't be eliminated or reduced in amount.
- As with quarterly assessments, these **are NOT charged to your card on AutoPay, and must be paid separately.**
- This year, the BOD charged \$50 in March for Flag members only, for the bathroom renovation.
- This year, the BOD is charging \$120 for Flag members only, for the parking lot repaving to be billed monthly July-December at \$20/month.

AutoPay: While AutoPay makes invoicing/paying significantly easier, **AutoPay doesn't cover all invoices from the Club.** It only covers Dues/Storage Fees. Additionally, the AutoPay system was changed to a new process in January 2020. It appears that many members didn't get the email outlining how to sign up for the new AutoPay system, and have become delinquent. If this is the case, and you want to sign up again for AutoPay, please contact Roger Bradley (Financial Secretary), or Jen Remelb (Secretary) to walk you through the process.

Payments can be made in person at the Club during business hours, on the Membership Portal (www.sdmbbsc.org), or by Mail using Cash (don't mail), Check, or Credit Card.
