## San Diego Youth Kayak Clinic at SDMBBSC

August 21, 2022 marked the last day for the San Diego Youth Kayak Clinic. Starting in July 2022 for 5 hours on Sundays and 1 Saturday. with tide specific start times, SDMBBSC held a kayak and wildlife program for 3-6th grade students from the San Diego Unified School District.

Under Brian Niznik's initiative and leadership we applied for a grant from the San Diego Foundation and awarded a grant over \$17000. Steve McMahon through OMBAC Angel 501c3 was able to administrate the grant for the program. We were able to purchase 10 2-man kayaks, paddles, children's PFD's, radios and whistles. Ocean Connectors, an education consulting firm provided education and wildlife curriculum for the program.
